
In 2022, Promise leapt forward! We have the people, plans, and process, and we have you, our supporters, who fuel this mission.



A PROMISE STORY

Over the past few years, a mother faced challenges that led her three children to journey in and out of foster care. This past year she was able to be reunited with her kids, and this time she was surrounded by a Primary Care Community made up of local church members to help make this reunification a success. The church Care Community came together to not only provide meals, child care, and celebrate birthdays, but they also helped to make the living situation safe and manageable. The Care Community assisted in a down payment for rent, tackled projects like putting in new flooring, hiring an electrician and a plumber, securing new furniture, and even painting the new space. The mother shared the following summary:

"Our experience with Promise686 has been nothing short of amazing. From the very first time the kids and I met with our Care Community, we could feel the presence of God and an outpouring of love. The kindness from everyone on our team is exactly what the world needs more of. It is never easy asking for help and honestly, even harder sometimes to accept it.

When I received a call about being referred to Promise686, I felt so embarrassed and ashamed that I was even in a situation where I needed help. But from the moment we met with one of the families, those feelings began to fade away and were replaced with feelings of hope and love that can only come from God. The greatest part of this experience has been the connection with the entire team. We have all heard "it takes a village," but I think we get so wrapped up in the chaos of life that we forget we need to *lean* on our village. I feel like that is what the team has been: our village, our tribe.


The meals and groceries, the gatherings, the invites, the birthday celebrations, the gifts, the selfless hours of time to help get a home ready, the planning to help make moving almost stress-free, the donations, and the time have all been a huge blessing and one that could never be given enough thanks for. **But the** greatest blessing is knowing that we have a group of people that care about us, pray for us and with us, and show us love that hasn't always been shown so freely."

The children are thriving at home, where they belong, because this mom was given a second chance to take care of her family with the support of a local church.

THE PROMISE NETWORK

The Promise Network is a group of churches and organizations nationwide that are committed to living the promise God makes in Psalm 68:6 to set "the lonely in families." As part of The Promise Network, our partners receive training, resources, and ongoing staff support from Promise686.

Because of our generous donors, we were able to continue mobilizing churches in 2022, growing The Promise Network to 1,335 CHURCHES NATIONWIDE.





PROMISE ADOPTION GRANTS

In 2022, Promise awarded \$202,039 in support for adoption, post placement, and legal grants. One of the families who received adoption support was the Gray family.

"My husband and I embarked on this adoption journey six years ago. Through classes we took, we learned we were chosen to adopt.

We got the call this year on Easter Monday that they had a baby girl for us! Oh what a joy and blessing our Hope Nuola Gray has been to us and to everyone who meets her. Her smile lights up the room! God is amazing and we praise Him daily!"

PROMISE SERVES

impact + features

In order to support children and families most effectively, churches utilize Promise Serves, a software platform Promise686 built in-house to serve our affiliate and church partners. In 2022, we added 26 videos and 93 training resources to the already robust media library. 481 advocates spent over 2,400 hours in Promise Serves to equip themselves and their church ministries to better support children and families. This ultimately led to Promise partners supporting 12,015 children.


