A Church Blesses Caseworkers in Atlanta



Christ Covenant Church has created a care team to support and encourage caseworkers who serve vulnerable children and families in Atlanta. Convicted by the statistic that a child is four times less likely to achieve permanency with multiple caseworkers as opposed to one, the team aims to be a catalyst for the local church to improve retention and to create support for frontline caseworkers.

The team's first initiative was to rally the church to write 200 handwritten letters to Fulton County caseworkers as a part of the "We See You" campaign during National Hospitality Week in October. The heart behind National Hospitality Week is to show radical hospitality to caseworkers, who are often unseen and overworked despite their crucial role in the wellbeing of our communities.

Christ Covenant is excited and thankful to be a part of this national movement as they begin to build long term relationships with local caseworkers.

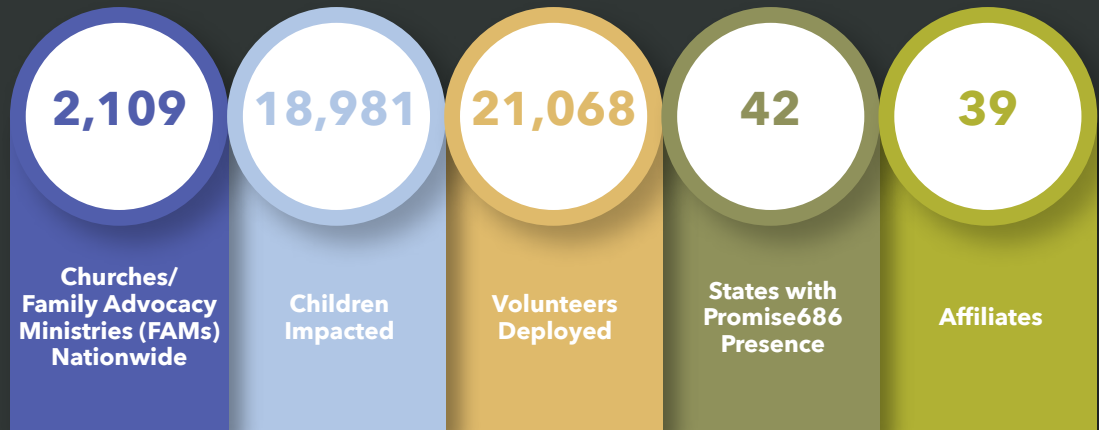

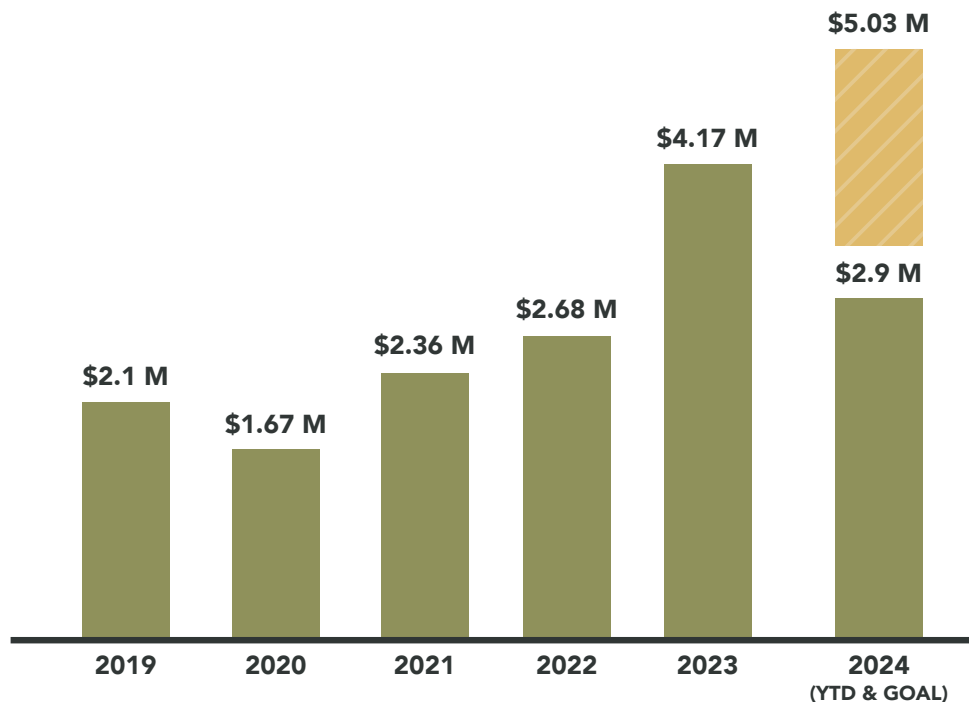
